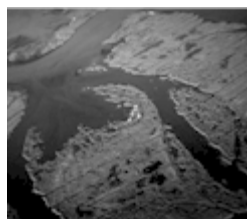

OUR INCUMBENT ASSEMBLYMAN'S VOTING RECORD

The Kings Park Psychiatric Center is New York State property. Our New York State Assemblyman, Michael Fitzpatrick, failed to introduce any legislation to postpone the sale of the Kings Park Psychiatric Center to Arker, a development corporation proposing to build 1800 units on the property. The town's schools and roads could not handle this increase in population. Where was Fitzpatrick when we needed him? He voted against funding to remediate Kings Park Psychiatric Center. Assemblyman Fitzpatrick also voted against the following legislation. I disagree with his votes.

Ref#	Description
A03637	The Fair Pay Act- Provides pay equity for employees regardless of sex, race and/or national origin .
A00004A	The Campaign Finance Reform Act of 2006—provides for public financing of campaigns and tighter limits on spending. encouraging competition and thus the pressure on incumbents to produce .
A02718	PSC oversight of LIPA increases: requires oversight by the Public Service Commission regarding the types of costs that are recovered through automatic adjustments to gas and electric rates
A02048	Wetlands protection legislation—protection for wetlands vulnerable to development
A02912A	Timothy's Law—prohibits "the exclusion or limitation of benefits for mental illness... in certain health insurance plans."
A06300A	Establishing New York State institute for stem cell research...to promote the development of life-saving and life-enhancing regenerative medical treatments, therapies and cures by providing financial and other support for stem cell research and activities related to regenerative medicine.
A11498A	Medicaid Fraud Act - with whistle blower clause recommended by US Senator Charles Grassly (R Iowa). Other states have recovered billions of dollars with this clause.
A04040	Prevailing Wage Act that would provide for "additional penalties for failure to pay prevailing wages or supplements. " This law would discourage the hiring of illegal immigrants.

Fitzpatrick has been ineffective and his "No" votes narrow minded. He complains that Albany is dysfunctional, not being able to bring any bills to the floor of the assembly during his term. Even his "No" votes don't count. Well the assembly functions on a majority rules basis. So for Long Islanders to be heard, a majority representative should be speaking for us. That's why I am asking for your vote on November 7th.
